## How to Apply for a Subsidized Library Card

#### What is the Library Card Subsidy Program?

The membership fee for the Nelson Library is \$90 per household or \$45 for a single membership (maximum 5 items) for residents of the Regional District of the Central Kootenay (RDCK) whose residence is not in a library service area. For those for whom this fee presents a barrier, the Library Card Subsidy will cover half the cost (\$45 for household/\$23 for single) of a yearly membership for those that qualify. The recipients of the Subsidy will be required to pay for the other half (\$45 for household/\$23 for single).

Subsidies for Area E residents are supported through a grant provided by the RDCK Area E.

#### Who can apply?

RDCK area residents without universal library access through taxation qualify when their combined gross income falls within or below the "Low Income" levels recognized by Statistics Canada.
